Transition Plan 2024/2025

- The table below outlines the proposals for managing and co ordinating the transition of learners from our partner primary schools to St Illtyd`s Catholic High School. It provides dates and accompanying activities. As well as these there are regular Headteacher meetings which discuss and evaluate the process as it goes through the year.
- In 2023/2024 St Illtyd`s Catholic High School admitted pupils from 24 different primary schools. This makes continuity of learning exceedingly challenging.
- There is a focus on literacy and Numeracy development amongst all our schools as you would expect. With three of our four Catholic partner schools we are looking at progression steps in Art and a transitional piece on Racism as a focus for 2024/2025.
- Information both academic, (Learning) and pastoral, (Wellbeing), is shared between all schools involved in Transition. This is done electronically and in face-to-face meetings.

This allows St Illtyd`s staff to support each individual learner`s progression as they transfer from primary to Secondary school.

- Our enhanced transition process ensures there is a continuity of learning and care for our ALN and more vulnerable pupils. Again, this involves sharing information electronically and face to face.
- These systems and processes are reviewed during and at the end of each academic year in respect of how it has helped achieve continuity of learning and supported individual learner progression
