Dear parent or guardian,

The School Nursing Immunisation Team will visit school on **27/09/2024** to offer children a **nasal spray flu vaccine**.


**The NHS recommends that your child has a flu vaccination every year.**

Please read the information enclosed and complete the consent form as soon as possible and no later than 72 hours before the day of the session. Any late forms may result in your child not receiving the nasal flu spray at school and an offer of a catch-up clinic will be made. - **they are prescribed oral steroids**
- **they become wheezy, or**
- **your child has already received the vaccine elsewhere.**
