*Nearly all parents thought that the school offers a range of interesting learning experiences including education trips and visits. A few parents mentioned in the additional comments that they would like to see more trips offered. At present we offer a learning experience (trip) at the start of the new topic/ theme and an annual residential outdoor pursuit experience in the junior school during the summer term. However, we are increasingly mindful of the current financial situation in the UK and its impact on our local communities. We are focusing on inviting visitors and developing hands on learning experience in the school.
