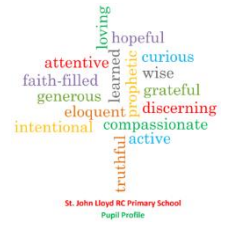

Nursery & Reception

Seesaw

Seesaw is an online learning journal of pupils' work that St John Lloyd Primary has invested in for our Early Years as a way to track the progress of our pupils learning. Pupils at this stage are not ready to record their own work independently.

At SJL we regularly share the Seesaw process with our Early Years parents to help them to work at home with their children in these early formative years. As pupils become more independent, there is an expectation that their work will be recorded in their learning workbooks. In Y1 & Y2, SeeSaw will be used on occasions when the class teacher views appropriate.

Year 1 to Year 6

Bug Club & My Maths

From Year 1 to Year 6 all pupils move onto a different process for homework and the recording of pupil's progress for assessment purposes.

Homework from Year 1 will consist of;

1. Reading – Bug Club <https://www.activelearnprimary.co.uk/login?c=0>
2. Maths – My Maths <https://www.mymaths.co.uk/>
3. Weekly Spelling/ Phonics

All logins are shared by the class teacher and given to parents in Y1-3 and independently through pupils HWB accounts in Y4-6. The expectancy is for the above activities to be completed weekly. Homework clubs are provided for pupils in Y3-6. Parents must accompany pupils in Y1 & Y2 if they want to access devices in homework clubs.

In line with school policy and Welsh Government guidance, pupils progress, attainment and ways forward are discussed and shared at termly parents' evenings. There is also an opportunity to view pupils' books at these meeting.
