Dear Parent/Carer,

This is the latest update regarding the ongoing investigation into the threats made to Llanishen High School and Eastern High School.

South Wales Police continued enquiries in to last night, including checks and searches. No evidence has been found of any person attending either school posing a threat.

Enquiries to identify the person(s) responsible are continuing, with an updated assessment from police following the investigations to date confirming they have no objections to the reopening of the schools.

It is therefore likely that both schools will reopen tomorrow (Wednesday, 18<sup>th</sup> March). To support this, staff at Llanishen and Eastern will meet today to finalise plans for additional measures designed to offer reassurance to pupils, parents, carers, and the wider school community.

We understand how concerning this situation continues to be, but hope you are reassured by the actions including school closure, taken with the safety of pupils, staff, and the wider school communities in mind.

Thank you for your patience and understanding.

Further updates will be shared as soon as more information becomes available.
